- Feifei: Wow, I didn't know we have so many different languages spoken in our office.
- Helen: Well, BBC Learning English is a department with hidden language talents. But is this the case with British people in general?
- Feifei: 大家好,我是冯菲菲。欢迎收听英国问答 Ask About Britain,我们在这个节目 中专门回答有关英国文化习俗的各种问题。今天和我在一起的是 Helen.
- Helen: Hello everyone. We have made many programmes on how people learn English, but today we're answering a question from a different angle.
- Feifei: 我们的问题来自重庆的朋友 Circle. 他想知道英国人的外语能力怎样?
- Helen: Do people in Britain speak other languages? Are they any good at learning foreign languages?
- Feifei: 英国人对自己的外语能力是怎么看的呢?
- Helen: Lindsey is a secondary school teacher. Let's hear from her first.

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They speak a lot of European languages. You have to do French or German and that's compulsory, up to GCSE. There is a desire to learn more languages; it's beneficial now to be able to speak a number of different languages. It helps with your career. But we don't have an automatic strength in it. No.

- Helen: Lindsey feels that students have the desire to learn more languages. It helps with people's careers.

Helen:	But British people are not very good at learning foreign languages, they don't have an automatic strength in it. This means they're not naturally good at languages.
Feifei:	不过很多英国人的外语能力不是很好,这不是他们的强项 they don't have an automatic strength in it.
Helen:	And even though learning a foreign language is compulsory at school, if you don't have the chance to practise, it's easily forgotten.

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I learned French for five years. As time goes on and on, I keep forgetting more.

I also learned French at school, as well, but unfortunately I don't know any French now.

- Feifei: 看来5年的外语必修课不一定能保证学生对外语的掌握程度。
- Helen: Headmaster Stephen Winkley has strong criticism of British people's attitude to learning foreign languages.

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British people are terribly bad with languages, and this is because they used to own an empire and everywhere they went in the world, so long as they spoke English and spoke it very loud, people would do what they wanted. As a result, there is a strong feeling in England that nobody needs to learn a foreign language. This is a disaster for our country and I'm very sad and embarrassed that it happens.

- Helen: Stephen says that British people are poor language learners and this has a historical reason.

- Helen: And Stephen feels that this lack of interest in learning foreign languages is a disaster for the UK.

- Helen: Now let's hear from people who are learning a new foreign language. What difficulties have they experienced?



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I'm sometimes OK and sometimes not so good. I think my memory isn't great, so I tend to forget new words, and also I'm a little bit lazy.

I'm a very lazy linguist. I like learning foreign languages, but I find it difficult to do out of context. So it's difficult to sit here in London and study Japanese when you don't actually have to use the language to communicate.
